Jonathan Ryan Gardner is the Founding Executive Director of GardHouse. With a decade of external and internal outreach experience, Jonathan has led engagement initiatives in the tech and government sectors. As ED of Charlotte's first work-based organization that primarily focuses on underserved college students, Jonathan developed paid internships within small businesses and nonprofits to demonstrate that they, too, can be economic drivers and training hubs for young talent. He launched GardHouse after finding that underserved college students were twice as likely to be unemployed than their counterparts for the last fifty years. Utilizing his outreach experience and Philadelphia upbringing as his foundation, Jonathan vowed to provide personalized experiences for students to excel in whatever field they choose. GardHouse has created over 200 opportunities for students, maintains a 100% employment rating 6 months after graduation, and a 4.5/5 employer satisfaction rating. As a result, Jonathan has received recognition in Forbes as a 30 Under 30 honoree and Charlotte Business Journals Power 100.

Molly Grantham has been named "TV News Reporter of the Year" and juggles life with humor and poise, bringing clever wit to diverse crowds. She delivers hundreds of keynotes and has interviewed over 15,000 people in her 25-years of television news. She is a 4x Emmy winner, 3x author, a national speaker, and proud mom. She is adept at speaking live to 100,000 people a night, sitting beside Hollywood celebrities, NFL stars, and throughout her career has worked at ABC, NBC, and CBS affiliates. She has appeared on CNN, Today Show, CBS News, the CBS Morning Show, and in Huffington Post and People Magazine. Her social media is its own channel, with more than 200,000 combined followers. In 2024, she founded the "Bet On Yourself Summit," a soul-filling experience to help women uncover power in themselves. It made history as the first women's event inside the Carolina Panthers NFL stadium. Molly is also a trained and active charity auctioneer, bringing non-profits around the country to earn record-breaking amounts. Her three books are a popular series described as "raw and relatable" about not losing yourself while loving your career and raising children. She and her husband, Wes, have three children under the age of 13. In her next life, Molly says she wants to be a mermaid.



S.T.A.R.S. Math & English Academy will prevent summer learning loss by providing a free research-based and engaging summer camp for 50 students rising to 3-9 grades. 



Each month, on average there are over 150 children in Mecklenburg County and the surrounding areas awaiting beds for mental health treatment. The <u>Katie Blessing Center</u> is a 72-bed behavioral health facility in Charlotte serving children ages 5-17 and is the largest facility of its kind in North Carolina. This facility will provide access to life-saving treatments for children, cutting the monthly bed shortage by close to 50%.


